School of Rural Management (SRM), is the academic wing of National Livelihood Resources Institute. NLRI is promoted by nationally reputed organizations namely Krishak Bharati Cooperative Limited (KRIBHCO) and Gramin Vikas Trust (GVT).

KRIBHCO was incorporated in 1980 as a leading Agribusiness Cooperative business entity of India and registered under the Multi-State Cooperative Societies (MSCS) Act, 2002. KRIBHCO's endeavor has always been to act as a catalyst to agricultural and rural development by identifying, financing and managing projects that are both socially desirable and commercially viable. In order to further this vision, KRIBHCO in 1999 established Gramin Vikas Trust, a national level no t for profit organization for bringing about a sustainable improvement in livelihood of the poor and marginalized communities, especially the tribal population including women.

GVT, in turn, established National Livelihood Resources Institute (NLRI) in 2006 with an objective to impart education to rural youth in the field of rural management, widen their knowledge base of the sector, enhance relevant skill sets and inculcate requisite attributes as demanded by the prevailing sector/industry standards. . It has a sprawling campus of 25 acres on the outskirts of Bhadwasa village off the southern bank of river Maleni and 23 kms north of the famous railway town, Ratlam.









The Program:

he School of Rural Management (SRM) was established in 2014. SRM offers a two year Post Graduate Diploma in Rural Management (PGDRM) which is approved by the All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE) vide its letter F. No. Central 1-/2087920291/2014/LOA, dated 30 April 2014.

Our program contains certain unique features:

Electives (1.5 credits each)

- 3. Social Entrepreneurship

Electives (3.0 credits each)

- 1. Sustainable Livelihoods
- 2. Rural Enterprise Management

- 4. Agri-value Chain Management
- 5. Management of Producer's Organization

Management Training Segments (MTSs) I & II (30 credits each)

The program offers two internship opportunities as an integral part of curriculum. These are called the Management Training Segment (MTS). Both, MTS-I and MTS-II, are of six weeks duration each and are commenced at the end of second and third semesters respectively. Students are placed with reputed organizations where they are either engaged by the host organizations in their ongoing projects or are offered fresh assignments. Most of the host organizations offer honorarium.

The interns are required to prepare a report under the guidance of SRM's faculty and present to the host organization.

During these two carefully designed Management Training Segments students find a unique learning opportunity to get themselves acquainted about functioning of rural enterprises in real time, real place, real context and the finer points of the development challenges.

These two hands-on exposures provide students with useful insights to expand knowledge perspectives and to augment their abilities for formulating gainful career plan with entrepreneurial abilities.











Internship & Placements

he School has established a placement cell to coordinate placements for its graduating students. SRM is proud to announce that its graduates of last four batches (2014-2017) have been suitably placed in different organizations while some students have opted for self startups/selfenterprises.
